XIII TRANSATLANTIC WORKSHOP ON THE ECONOMICS OF CRIME

This 13th workshop will continue the sequence of Economics of Crime workshops in Paris (2009), Bonn (2010), Torino (2011), Rotterdam (2012), Frankfurt (2013), Milan (2014), London (2015), Stockholm (2016), Philadelphia (2017), Paris (2018), Amsterdam (2019), and Gothenburg (2021)

The workshop will be held **in person** at Bocconi University **in Milan, Italy** on **7-8 October, 2022**. In the unfortunate event that travel restrictions prevent some presenters from being in Milan, Bocconi's new campus features modern auditoriums that allow for hybrid conferences with excellent quality of audio/video.

We aim to bring together researchers from both sides of the Atlantic to present and discuss their work, allowing for an in-depth interaction between those working on the empirical and theoretical analysis of crime and illegal behavior.

The workshop will consist of **15-18 contributed papers**, to be presented in 30-minute or 10-minute ("lightning") sessions, and **two keynote lectures** by **CRYSTAL YANG** (Harvard) and **FEDERICO VARESE** (Oxford).

This year's edition will focus particularly on **organized crime** and **corruption**, but it is not limited to these topics. Other suggested topics include the following:

- **Judicial decisions**
- **White collar crimes**
- **Social prevention of crime and violence**
- **Early childhood interventions**
- **Evaluation of police crime reduction strategies**
- **Re-entry and rehabilitation interventions**
- **Guns/weapons (and related policies) and crime**
- **Social interactions, networks, and crime**
- **Crime and the labor markets**
- **Economic crises, poverty, inequality and crime**
